We are pleased to provide this letter of support for the Orange County Soccer Club (OCSC) and their proposal to operate Championship Soccer Stadium at Irvine's Great Park.

Rangers FC of Glasgow is a Scottish Premiership soccer team that has been partners with OCSC for the past two years.
